COMMON PROPOSALS FOR THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE

Pursuing the aim of strengthening international cooperation in telecommunications, the member administrations of RCC have drawn up these proposals, considering that a balanced and agreed policy for the development, implementation and use of modern telecommunication and ICT facilities, for reducing the digital technology divide in areas including broadband access, standardization and security, and for establishing an enabling environment and building capacity in the area of ICT, will enable the countries of our region to advance successfully towards the establishment of an inclusive, development-oriented information society in which the interests of people are considered to be of paramount importance.
