UK INPUT TO QUESTIONNAIRE ON ITU RESOLUTION 1305 ANNEX 1 ISSUES

The United Kingdom attaches in Annex A to this contribution its response to the CWG Internet questionnaire on what actions have or are to be undertaken by the UK government in relation to each of the International Internet-related public policy issues identified in Annex 1 to Resolution 1305.

The UK government supports a multi-stakeholder approach to Internet governance issues both in a national and international context. The UK government is a firm believer that the ITU Council Working Group on Internet Public Policy Issues should be open up to all relevant stakeholders who wish to participate, where we believe it would bring greater depth in discussions and output of the group moving forward.
